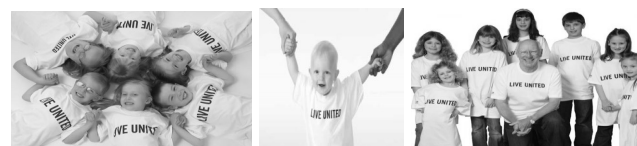

- Provide children nurturing, educational and safe daycare opportunities.

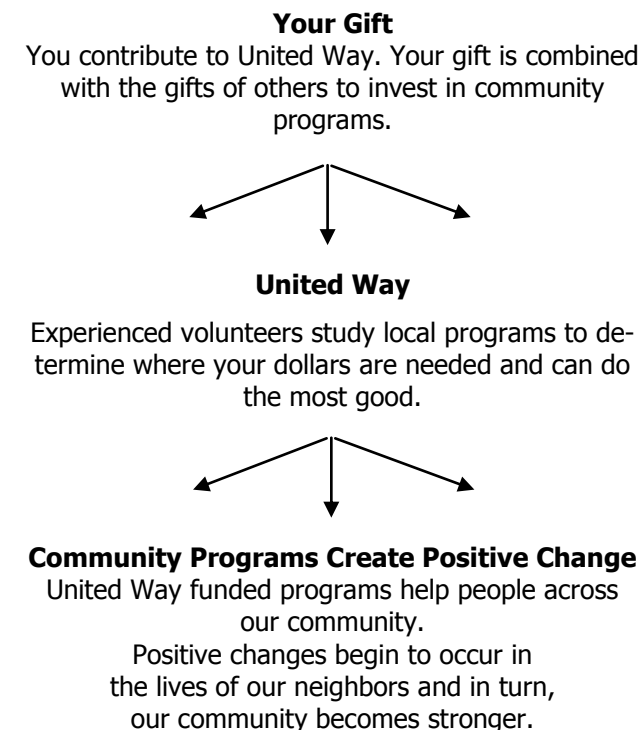

FYI (FAMILY & YOUTH INVOLVEMENT) CENTER



FYI serves as the venue for mentoring, academic assistance, computer technology, health & fitness, service learning clubs, community service opportunities, juvenile diversion, substance abuse prevention education and positive parenting classes. With the assistance of AmeriCorps Members, and leadership from the Jefferson Community Coalition, more than 200 unduplicated youth were served last program year.

HOPE CRISIS CENTER



Hope Crisis Center is a non-profit organization committed to empowering victims of domestic violence and sexual assault as well as our communities. Advocacy, education and confidential emergency services are offered to victims and their families free of charge in the counties of Jefferson, Thayer, Fillmore, York, Seward, Saline and Gage. 24-Hour Crisis Line support is available by calling 1-877-388-HOPE (4673). Community education and presentations are available through direct contact with our office.

NEW BEGINNINGS



New Beginnings helps those in need by providing low cost home needs, retail job skills and support towards self sufficiency. Families have the option of volunteering for the items they need, giving them a feeling of self worth and learning some job seeking/job keeping skills.

SALINE COUNTY AGING SERVICES



Saline County Aging Services (SCAS) provides services to county residents age 60+ and their caregivers. Services include information and referral, home delivered meals, foot clinics, health fairs, Tai Chi classes and other health and wellness activities, social events and assistance with accessing benefits such as Medicaid, Medicare and Homestead Exemption. SCAS also offers free medical equipment loans to any Saline County resident regardless of age and administers the Community Food Pantry which serves low income families and individuals within Saline County.

Our Agencies

KIDS CONNECTION, INC



A nonprofit childcare facility licensed since 1989, the center serves children ages 6 weeks to 13 years. The facility serves children from all income levels with the majority being from low-income families. Approximately 80 children attend daily.

COMMUNITY ACTION PARTNERSHIP OF LANCASTER AND SAUNDERS COUNTIES



For 50 years, Community Action has been providing supportive services to those facing poverty in our community. The agency offers more than 20 programs and services designed to provide individuals and families the tools, resources and support they need to become self-reliant. In Saunders County, Cornhusker United Way funds help families in crisis with: rent and utilities assistance, weatherization services to make homes more energy efficient, and comprehensive services for children and families through Early Head Start and Head Start child development programs.

FRIENDS OF BLUE VALLEY



BVCA provides volunteer opportunities for sharing time and talents. Serve as council, advisory group and/or board member. Participate in fundraising, center activities, issue advocacy, holiday projects, classroom volunteers and promotional events. The opportunities are endless!

RELEASED AND RESTORED



Released and Restored is a prison and re-entry ministry dedicating to responding to the question – “After Prison – Then What?” We prepare inmates for their release to local neighborhoods and communities by providing programs that teach decision-making, goal-setting, and problem-solving skills, as well as teaching job readiness/life skills that focus on basic money management and how to obtain and maintain gainful employment after release. We serve inmates from each of Nebraska’s 93 counties.

SALINE COUNTY AREA TRANSIT



Saline County Area Transit assists the elderly and disabled as well as the general public with their transportation needs, often providing the level of independence required to stay in their own home. SCAT also improves quality of life by enabling all residents to shop, bank, doctor, travel to and from school, visit family and friends, and enjoy entertainment outside their homes. SCAT provides more than 10,000 rides and travels over 120,000 miles per year.

FILLMORE COUNTY RURAL TRANSIT



Fillmore County Rural Transit provides public transport for all residents of Fillmore County. Providing rides for the elderly and disabled allows them to stay in their homes as well as keep their independence as they can schedule their own appointments and shopping outings. All ages are served, as children are transported to school for working parents. Serving a county with a population of 6,600, over 8,600 rides were given last year. Approximately 100 riders served monthly.

PIONEER FOSTER GRANDPARENTS



This program provides opportunities for individuals 55 and older to provide one-on-one daily mentoring and attention to children with special or exceptional needs. Foster Grandparents are stationed at volunteer sites such as schools, preschool programs, Head Start centers and day care centers.

BLUE VALLEY COMMUNITY ACTION (BVCA)



BVCA is a charitable organization with the mission of “overcoming poverty by helping people, improving lives and strengthening communities.” Each year BVCA has touched the lives of over 12,000 low-to-moderate income persons in nine southeastern Nebraska counties. BVCA celebrates 50 years of service in 2016 and has mobilized resources to address family and community needs via opportunities within more than 30 programs with the desired outcome of increasing personal and family self-sufficiency and responsibility.
